Play therapy is a blooming field and in order to help it grow, supervision is an important component. This training will focus on the process of play therapy supervision, the roles and relationships of the supervisor and supervisees, playful activities that enhance the relationship and the ethical issues with play therapy.

1. Identify the roles and responsibilities of a play therapy supervisor and play therapy supervisee.
2. Practice and identify 5 play therapy interventions that enhance skill development and the supervisory relationship.
3. Understand the areas of competency and limitations of play therapy to help play therapists grow professionally.
4. Explore how playfulness can be incorporated in the supervision process.
5. Discuss ethical concerns in play therapy supervision and identify best practices according to APT standards.
